#### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended by the Finance, Police, Fire, Recreation and Parks Departments, the Office of Community Engagement and the Measure O Citizens' Oversight Committee that the Council, by motion, accept the Measure O Annual Report for FY 2017-18.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Ordinance 3680 added Chapter 3-26 to the Santa Rosa City Code establishing a special transactions and use tax known as Measure O. Each year an Annual Report is prepared by City staff, reviewed by the Measure O Citizen Oversight Committee and presented to the City Council reporting on revenue, expenditures and accomplishments during the past fiscal year.

#### BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

Ordinance 3680 added Chapter 3-26 to the Santa Rosa City Code establishing a special transactions and use tax. The special tax measure, known as Measure O, increased sales tax by a quarter percent to fund specific Police, Fire, and Gang Prevention/Intervention programs, as set forth in the Ordinance.

The Ordinance also established a seven-member Citizen Oversight Committee, with members appointed by the City Council, to annually review expenditures and appropriations of the tax revenues to ensure that all such revenues are spent or appropriated for the purposes and uses set forth in the Ordinance. Each year, an Annual Report is prepared by City staff, reviewed by the Citizen Oversight Committee and presented to the City Council reporting on expenditures and activities during the past fiscal year.

The tax revenues generated by Measure O are split between Fire (40%), Police (40%) and Gang Prevention/Intervention Programs (20%), with these revenues spent in accordance with an Implementation Plan which was adopted by the City Council.

# PRIOR CITY COUNCIL REVIEW

The Council has accepted annual reports on Measure O activities every year since inception.

#### **ANALYSIS**

On September 26, 2018, staff presented the annual report of revenues, expenditures and accomplishments associated with tax revenues for FY 2017-18 to the Measure O Citizen Oversight committee for their review. The Committee was provided a presentation by representatives from each Measure O program area outlining their revenues, expenditures and accomplishments during the past fiscal year. Committee members discussed the report and provided comments. The Committee recommended the report be forwarded to the City Council for approval with a vote of 5-0-2.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact from accepting the Annual Report.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT**

This action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) because it is not a project which has a potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment, or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, pursuant to CEQA Guideline section 15378.
