# Measure O

## CHOICE Grant Program

- Provides funding to organizations for youth and parenting programs focusing on anti-violence education, prevention, and intervention.
- Fulfills Measure O Ordinance Grant Requirements for Gang Prevention

# CYCLE IX, YEAR TWO

- Request for Qualifications for two-year cycle released in October 2017
- Based on RFQ submissions and Grant Review Team recommendation, Council adopted funding recommendations for 9 agencies for Year One agreements
- Eight agencies are eligible and seeking Year Two funding agreements in 2019

# RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Office of Community Engagement that the Council, by resolution: 1) Adopt the funding recommendations of the Grant Review Team for year two of the Cycle IX Measure O Community Helping Our Indispensable Children Excel (CHOICE) grant program for Calendar Year 2019 and direct the City Manager or designee to enter into funding agreements with approved providers; and 2) authorize the City Manager or designee to approve and execute the funding agreements and amendments with CHOICE Cycle IX funded agencies, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.
