SRTBIA: Overview

- SRTBIA established August 3, 2010 Ordinance 3946
- 3% Assessment on lodging establishments, including hotels, motels, inns, vacation rentals, and all similar lodging businesses
- Distribution of Funds Collected:
 - 30%: City of Santa Rosa, Economic Development Division
 - 70%: Santa Rosa Chamber of Commerce, Visit Santa Rosa Program



SRTBIA: Advisory Board

ADVISORY BOARD

5 members appointed by City Council:

- 1 Santa Rosa Chamber of Commerce employee
- 1 City of Santa Rosa employee
- 3 hotel operators, at least 1 full service, and 1 select service

Ordinance 3946, Section 6-56.400:

The Advisory Board shall thereafter be subject to Council Policy No. 006-06. Notwithstanding any Council Policy that may now or hereafter exist to the contrary, City employees shall serve on the Advisory Board. The Advisory Board shall advise the City Council on the amount of the Area's Assessments and on the services, programs, and activities to be funded by the Assessments, and shall perform such other duties as required by Law, including preparing the Annual Report required by Section 36533 of the Law. The Advisory Board shall meet as often as necessary to accomplish its goals, but no less than once each calendar quarter.
