David,

At your request Crane Transportation Group has projected the expected weekday daily, AM and PM peak hour traffic that would be generated by your proposed 92-unit (98-bed) assisted living facility to be located on Piner Road in Santa Rosa, California. Trip rates for this analysis are from the traffic engineering profession's standard source of trip rate data, *Trip Generation*, 10th Edition, by the Institute of Transportation Engineers, 2017. Projections are presented below in Table 1.

As shown, daily trips would total 256, and would be split evenly, with 50 percent entering and 50 percent exiting. During the AM peak hour there would be a projected 12 inbound and 7 outbound trips, while during the PM peak hour there would be a projected 10 inbound and 16 outbound trips. This very low-level peak hour trip generation would not be expected to result in significant impacts at nearby intersections.

Note that the conceptual site plan, dated 8/27/18, provides for 40 on-site parking spaces. Parking supply exceeds the minimum City of Santa Rosa zoning code requirement for Community Care Facility – 7 or more clients¹: 1 space for each 3 beds (a requirement of 33 parking spaces).
