Executive Summary

The 2018 edition of IRONMAN Santa Rosa, held in May 2018, brought over 5,200 visitors to the Santa Rosa area, and generated an estimated total impact of \$9.1 Million for the County.

This impact was calculated with data collected from a post-event participant survey, as well as registration and participation data provided by the IRONMAN organization.

These figures do not include direct spend by the IRONMAN organization within Sonoma County companies. Examples include, AMR, athlete meals, equipment rental, local paid temporary workers and grants given to local organizations as volunteer groups.

All analysis and calculations were performed by an independent third-party consultant.
