RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA APPROVING THE RE-CERTIFICATION OF THE SANITARY SEWER MANAGEMENT PLAN AS REQUIRED BY THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD ORDER NO. 2006-0003 STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SANITARY SEWER SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, on May 2006, the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Order No. 2006-0003-Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems (WDR) was adopted and implemented; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the WDR is to develop a regulatory mechanism to provide a consistent statewide approach for reducing sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs); and

WHEREAS, the WDR required preparation of a Sanitary Sewer Management Plan (SSMP) to provide a plan and schedule to properly manage, operate, and maintain all parts of the sanitary sewer system in order to help reduce and prevent SSOs, as well as mitigate any SSOs that do occur; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with WDR requirements, a SSMP was prepared by the Utilities Department, recommended for approval by the Board of Public Utilities on April 16, 2009 and approved by Council on April 28, 2009 through Resolution 27356; and

WHEREAS, the WDR requires update and re-certification of SSMPs after five calendar years; and

WHEREAS, the SSMP, updated in March 2014 and ready for re-certification, must be approved by City Council prior to re-certification; and

WHEREAS, the City Council must approve the SSMP for online re-certification within the California Integrated Water Quality System database.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities has reviewed the SSMP and passed a resolution on April 17, 2014 recommending re-certification of the SSMP by City Council as required by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Order No. 2006-0003 Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council, by resolution, approves the SSMP for re-certification as required by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Order No. 2006-0003 Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems.




