# **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Council will consider re-appointments to fill two of four vacancies on the Board of Building Regulations Appeals.

# **BACKGROUND**

The Board of Building Regulations Appeals has vacancies due to expiring terms that have not been filled. The following terms are currently vacant. All four positions are to serve terms expiring on December 31, 2022:

#### PRIOR CITY COUNCIL REVIEW

# <u>ANALYSIS</u>

Board of Building Regulations Appeals members are appointed by the full Council. Per City Code Section 18-04.050 it is desirable but not required that candidates be active in their field and are qualified by experience and training to pass upon matters pertaining to building construction. All persons interested in serving on City boards, commissions, and committees must submit an application.

The City Clerk's Office conducted a recruitment for applications. The following persons have submitted applications for consideration:

Board/Committee	Applicant
Board of Building Regulations Appeals	Peter Hendrickson (Incumbent)
Board of Building Regulations Appeals	Greg Hurd (Incumbent)

Mr. Hendrickson has served one term on the Board of Building Regulations Appeals, since March 2017.

Mr. Hurd has served multiple terms on the Board of Building Regulations Appeals, since January 2009.

The Council's Appointment Policy sets out the following appointment procedures for appointments made by the full Council, specific to incumbents, under Section E:

Council's Appointment Policy:

#### Section E - Incumbents

- At the end of the first term, an incumbent board, commission or committee member may, at the discretion of the Council or appointing Council member, be reappointed for an additional term without the need to apply or interview for re-appointment. In lieu of an application, the board, commission, or committee member shall submit to the City Clerk's Office a letter of interest in re-appointment prior to the expiration of the member's first term.
- 2. Any incumbent interested in re-appointment who has served two or more terms must apply for re-appointment as set forth in Section F.

# Section F - Application

"Except as set forth in Section E.1, all persons considered for appointment or reappointment shall complete an application form. This application form must be

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received by the City Clerk's Office at least five (5) days prior to the appointment taking effect."

Both incumbents have submitted applications.

Section H.1.a – Appointment Proceed for Board and Commission Members Appointed by the full Council/Review of Applications:

"Subject to review by the Council, the Mayor may establish a procedure for review of applications and selection of applicants for interview, for those board, commission and committee members appointed by the full Council. Such selection and interview may be conducted by a committee of the Council or the full Council."
