

Contract Award – Franklin Avenue Pedestrian Path

BACKGROUND

- This project will construct a sidewalk on the west side of Franklin Avenue between Monroe Avenue and Terrace Way. A pedestrian crossing from Terrace Way across Franklin Avenue will be installed along with ADA ramp upgrades.
- This path will provide an effective ADA path of travel for residents and bridge a gap in the current pedestrian infrastructure.

ANALYSIS

- The project was advertised on 3/29/19; five bids were received on 4/23/19, ranging from \$293,665.50 to \$473,398.30.
- The low bid was 25% under the Engineer's estimate.
- Construction is anticipated to begin in July of 2019 and last 20 working days.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by motion, award construction Contract No. C00779, Franklin Avenue Pedestrian Path, in the amount of \$293,665.50 to the lowest responsible bidder, Siri Grading and Paving, Inc. of Santa Rosa, California; approve a 15% contract contingency; and authorize a total contract amount of \$337,715.33.
- Funding for this project has been appropriated to Account No. 17346.
