- 1) PRESERVATION APPEARS TO BE POSSIBLE.
- 2) REMOVAL IS REQUIRED DUE TO SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENT IMPACTS
- 3) REMOVAL IS REQUIRED DUE TO POOR HEALTH OF POOR HABITAT/STRUCTURE
- 4) REMOVAL IS REQUIRED DUE TO SIGNIFICANT EQUIPMENT IMPACTS AND POOR COSTING CONDITION
- 5) ONLY STUMP IS PRESENT.
- 6) INSTALL TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE FENCING AT THE EDGE OF THE DRAINAGE, OR EDGE OF APPROVED EROSION CONTROL MEASURES TO PREVENT REMOVAL OF CONSTRUCTIVE WATERSHED FENCING IN PLACE FOR DURATION OF ALL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY IN THE AREA.
- 7) MAINTAIN EXISTING STUMP PRIOR TO REMOVAL TO PREVENT LOSS OF THE DRAINAGE, ROSTER ORANGE SHAPES AND ALL UNDERGROUND LINES OUTSIDE THE DRAINAGE.
- 8) PLACE A 4" LAYER OF CHIPPED BARK MULCH OVER THE SOIL SURFACE WITHIN THE FENCED DRAINAGE TO PREVENT TEMPORARY FENCING. MAINTAIN THIS LAYER OF MULCH THROUGHOUT CONSTRUCTION.
- 9) THIS TREE IS EXEMPT FROM PRESERVATION AND MITIGATION PER THE SANTA ROSA TREE ORDINANCE.
- 10) THE EXISTING AREA IS A REMOVED DRAINAGE, AND IS NOT UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE ANABORNETE PLANNING DEPARTMENT'S PLANNING TO OCCUR BY, OR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF, AN ANABORNETE CERTIFIED BY THE ISA.
