

# Contract Award – Accessibility Alterations at Howarth Park, 630 Summerfield Road

## **BACKGROUND**

Title II of the Americans with Disabilities
Act (ADA) requires local public entities to
Self-Evaluate their programs, activities and
services to determine barriers to persons
with disabilities and create a Transition
Plan to identify a process to remove
barriers.

#### **BACKGROUND**

- The City of Santa Rosa completed its original Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan in 1993, which was updated in 2006 and amended in 2012.
- Staff prioritized barrier removal at Howarth Park due to its high use and unique programs that are not offered at other facilities.

## **ANALYSIS**

- The project was advertised on 6/20/19; 2 bids were received on 7/10/19, ranging from \$849,077.00 to \$861,798.00.
- The low bid was 45% over the Engineer's estimate.
- The length of the contract is 65 working days. Construction is expected to be completed by Spring 2020.

#### RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by motion, award Contract No. C02131, Accessibility Alterations at Howarth Park, in the amount of \$849,077.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, M3 Integrated Services, Inc. of Santa Rosa, CA, approve at 10% contract contingency, and authorize a total contract amount of \$933,984.70. The source of funds is Transportation and Public Works Capital Improvement Program.
