

RESOLUTION NO. RES-2019-133

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA DELEGATING APPROVAL AND SIGNATURE AUTHORITY FOR ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITS AND APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, routine operations, maintenance, and implementation of capital improvement projects may require numerous environmental permits from local, state, and federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, delegating authority to the Assistant City Manager over Transportation & Public Works and the Director of the Water Department, or their designees, to submit applications and execute environmental permits with California Department of Fish & Wildlife, County of Sonoma, Regional Water Quality Control Board, State Water Resources Control Board, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency would allow City staff to implement necessary public projects and provide service to the community in an efficient manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa authorizes the Assistant City Manager over Transportation & Public Works and Director of the Water Department, or their designees, to submit applications and approve and execute environmental permits with California Department of Fish & Wildlife, County of Sonoma, Regional Water Quality Control Board, State Water Resources Control Board, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for routine operations and maintenance and for Capital Improvement Program projects, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.
