

Reject All Bids – Pavement Preventive Maintenance 2019

BACKGROUND

- This project is an annual preventative maintenance project.
- Construction activities typically include crack sealing, asphalt patching, slurry sealing and some striping reconfiguration.


ANALYSIS

- The project was advertised on 5/2/19; two bids were received 5/21/19.
- Low bid was 41.7% over engineer's estimate
- Additional funding will need to be allocated to award this contract
- City Materials Engineering Lab staff reports that project may be delayed for up to a year without significant impact to street candidates.
- Rejecting bids will allow staff to rebid the project with the expectation of more competitive pricing.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, reject all bids for Construction Contract No. C02252 Pavement Preventive Maintenance 2019.
