

Request for Council Authorization Senate Bill 2 Grant Application

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BACKGROUND

- Building Homes and Jobs Act (SB 2, 2017)
 - Establishes a \$75 recording fee on real estate documents to increase the supply of affordable homes in California
 - Purpose of bill is to provide funding and technical assistance to all local governments in California
- Resolution to authorize filing of an application for \$310,000 grant for planning initiatives
 - Anticipated to accelerate the production of housing

PLANNING INITIATIVES

Missing Middle Housing

 Amend housing codes, policies, standards and fees to accommodate by right construction, replacement or conversion of standard single-family homes and remodels to produce "missing middle" infill housing

Historic Resource Evaluation

 Proactively identify properties within DSASP planning area that have historic significance

Growth Management

 Limits single family allotments to 75 per developer per year, and multi-family limited to 200 allotments per developer per year

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RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Planning and **Economic Development Department that** the Council, by resolution, approve the filing of a Senate Bill 2 Grant application for State funding in the amount of \$310,000, for various planning initiatives to accelerate or incentivize the production of housing.
