


# Approval of Amendment #1 to the Communications System and Services Agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc.

#### Current

- The Police Department's radio system is over 30 years old
- Parts are no longer available
- Frequency strength has been weakened
- Is not sufficient in supporting mutual aid

#### Proposed

#### Digital 700 MHz trunked system


- Increased reliability through microwave design, redundant switches and routers
- Digital radios
  - Portables
  - Mobiles



#### Additional Tower

- Additional tower site on Eastern ridge of the City (Barham)
- Expanded coverage not currently covered
- More reliable

# Radio Infrastructure Project Cost

Asset Forfeiture Fund Contributions	\$245,000
Crime Mitigation Fund Contributions	\$90,000
Existing Communications Project Appropriations	\$1,196,200
General Fund Reserves	\$3,772,000
