Cannabis vs Industrial Hemp

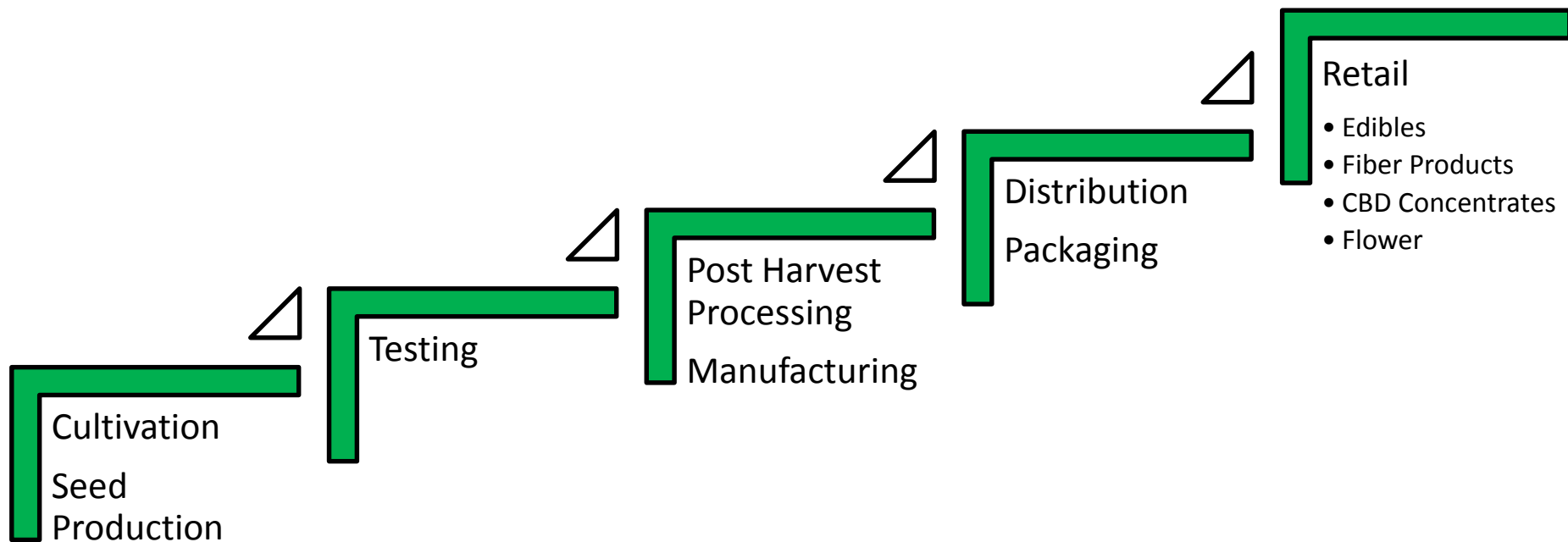
Hemp- 0.3% THC or less

Issue	Cannabis	Hemp
Odor	Yes	Yes
Security Concerns	Yes	Maybe
Banking Allowed?	No	Yes
Testing Required	Yes	Yes, but not products
Interstate Commerce Allowed?	No	Yes

Industrial Hemp- Agricultural Crop (Federal)

Cannabis- Agricultural Product (California)

Hemp Supply Chain Next Steps/Options

- A. *Allow- Zoning Interpretation (treat like ag product)
 - 1) Processing/Manufacturing
 - 2) Distribution/Packaging
 - 3) Nursery, Seeds
- B. Urgency Ordinance (treat like cannabis)- placeholder until comprehensive ordinance update including cannabis and hemp.

Hemp Retail

Next Steps/Options

- A. Allow- Zoning Interpretation (allow general retail)
 - 1) Fiber products
 - 2) Flower
 - 3) Hemp Derived CBD Edibles (food and drink)
 - 4) Hemp Derived CBD Oils and Concentrates
- A. *Urgency Ordinance (treat like cannabis)- placeholder until comprehensive ordinance update including cannabis and hemp.

(treat like agricultural product)

✓ Hemp Retail- Urgency Ordinance
(treat like cannabis)
