

SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT'S INFILL INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30 MILLION FOR A QUALIFIED INFILL AREA

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CURRENT

- California Department of Housing and Community Development's (HCD) Infill Infrastructure Grant (IIG) Program provides grant funding for infrastructure improvements associated with the development of affordable housing units.
- HCD guidelines require the submittal of the IIG application to be from a City or County or a joint application with a developer.

BENEFITS

- IIG provides grant funding for capital infrastructure improvements associated with the construction of affordable housing units
- The Renewal Enterprise District has developed an application for a Qualified Infill Area within the Downtown Station Area and Roseland Area Specific Plans

BENEFITS

The application for IIG funds will request up to \$30 million for infrastructure associated with 349 new housing units; 113 of which are affordable.

The Project is consistent with Council Tier 1 Goal: Meet Housing Needs

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Department of Housing and Community Services, in conjunction with the Renewal Enterprise District, that the Council, by resolution, approve the submittal of a grant application to the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development's In-fill Infrastructure Grant program in the amount not to exceed \$30 million for a Qualified Infill Area identified as the Santa Rosa Infill Infrastructure Qualifying Area.
