

Public Hearing: Petition to Establish the Olive Park Residential Permit Parking Zone


CURRENT

- The Olive Park neighborhood does not currently have a residential permit program.
- City Code Section 11-44.050 establishes process for establishing residential permit zones.
- This area is experiencing spill over parking from adjacent attractors, such as the Hyatt Hotel, Railroad Square and SMART commuters.

PROPOSED

- A petition has been received from residents of the Olive Park neighborhood to establish a residential permit parking zone.
- The zone will have two-hour time limited parking from 9 am to 6 pm, Monday – Friday.
- Residents may purchase permits exempting them from time limits.

PROPOSED OLIVE PARK RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE



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BENEFIT

- Approval of this item will improve access to parking for residents, allowing them to park beyond posted time limits in the permit zone.
- The two-hour time limit will serve as a deterrent to long term spill over parking, freeing up parking spaces for residents.

RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Finance Department that the City Council, by resolution, approve the petition to establish the Olive Park Residential Permit Parking Zone.
