
CURRENT

- The West End Residential Permit Parking Zone was established on November 5, 2019
- City Code Section 11-44.050 establishes process for designation
- An employee preferential permit program, in the commercial area of the West End adjacent to the proposed residential permit area, was approved by Council on August 13, 2019

PROPOSED

- A petition has been received from residents of the 100 block of 6th Street to expand the West End Residential Permit Parking Zone
- The zone will have two-hour time limited parking from 9 am to 6 pm, Monday -Saturday
- Residents may purchase permits exempting them from time limits

PROPOSED EXPANSION TO THE WEST END RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE



BENEFIT

- Approval of this item will provide relief to residents, allowing them to park beyond posted time limits in the permit zone.
- The two-hour time limit will serve as a deterrent to long term spill over parking, freeing up parking spaces for residents.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Finance
Department that the Council, by
resolution, approve the petition to expand
the West End Residential Permit Parking
Zone.
