











## CITY OF SANTA ROSA HOUSING PRODUCTION




## Housing Type Breakdown (non Fire Rebuild)



Units Applied refers to the number of residential housing units within the City limits applied for through the building permit process during the calendar year. A unit applied for in a calendar year may be, and is likely, completed in subsequent years.
