RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA AUTHORIZING A REQUEST FOR AN ESTIMATED \$371,499 IN LOW CARBON TRANSIT OPERATIONS PROGRAM (LCTOP) FUNDS FOR FY 2019-20 AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC WORKS TO EXECUTE THE CERTIFICATIONS AND ASSURANCES; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AUTHORIZED AGENT FORM

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Rosa is an eligible project sponsor and may receive state funding from the Low Carbon Transit Operations Program (LCTOP) for transit projects; and

WHEREAS, the statutes related to the state-funded transit projects require a local or regional implementing agency to abide by various regulations; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 862 (2014) named the California Department of Transportation (DOT) as the administrative agency for the LCTOP; and

WHEREAS, the DOT has developed guidelines for the purpose of administering and distributing LCTOP funds to eligible project sponsors (local agencies); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Santa Rosa wishes to delegate authority to execute these documents and any amendments thereto to the Director of Transportation and Public Works or his designee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Santa Rosa that the fund recipient agrees to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the Certifications and Assurances in Exhibit A to the Resolution, and the Authorized Agent documents and applicable statutes, regulations and guidelines for all LCTOP funded transit projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorizes the Director of Transportation and Public Works or his designee to execute the Certifications and Assurances for the LCTOP, attached as Exhibit A to the Resolution, and all required documents and any Amendments thereto with the DOT, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorizes the Mayor to execute the Authorized Agent forms for the LCTOP, attached as Exhibit B to the Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorizes the submittal of the following project nomination and allocation request to the DOT in FY 2019-20 LCTOP funds:

Project Name: Maintain Increased Frequency on Routes 1 and 2

Amount of LCTOP funds requested: \$371,499

Project Description: Improvements on Santa Rosa CityBus routes 1 and 2 Benefit to a Priority Population:

Route 2 connects with Route 15, providing improved access and faster travel times from the 12 stops within the Disadvantaged Community in southwestern Santa Rosa to shopping, medical facilities, community centers, parks, SMART rail service, and the Downtown Transit Mall

Contributing Sponsor: Metropolitan Transportation Commission
