CURRENT

- Transportation and Public Works -Transit Division was awarded \$2.9 million in federal grant funding for the purchase of four battery electric buses for the fixed route fleet
- Charging infrastructure development for future electric bus expansion is vital

PROPOSED

 Submit an application for grant funding to FTA

 If awarded the grant, purchase and install electric bus charging equipment



BENEFIT

Reduce greenhouse gas emissions

 Having been awarded funds for our first four electric bus purchases, we can implement a wider range of charging options to enhance our buses range capabilities

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works or designee to file and execute a grant application under the Federal Transit Administration Low or No **Emission Bus Discretionary Grant Program** requesting \$1,434,093 in federal funds for the purchase of electric bus charging equipment and installation costs, and appropriating any necessary matching funds.
