



# Ratification of Purchase Order For Fifteen 12-Lead EKG Monitor/Defibrillator Units and Accessories

# CURRENT

- The City of Santa Rosa had a need to replace current existing EKG equipment that are no longer supported by the manufacturer and do not have the ability to upgrade to the latest technology.
- Stryker's supply of the monitors was limited during the COVID-19 pandemic and a confirmed order was needed to honor original delivery timeline.

# BENEFIT

- Technologically advanced equipment.
- Additional capabilities to evaluate patient illnesses and treatments.
- EKG monitor can provide lifesaving electrical therapy for patients with cardiac issues.

# PROPOSED

- Based on the importance of these monitor/defibrillators for emergency operations, the City Manager approved a purchase order on March 23, 2020, under his emergency authority.
- It is requested that Council ratify the purchase of 15 12-Lead EKG Monitor/Defibrillator Units and Accessories that were previously approved by the City Manager.

# RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Fire and Finance Department and City Manager that the Council, by resolution, ratify the Purchase Order, approved by the City Manager under emergency authority, with Stryker Sales Corporation of Portage, Michigan, for fifteen 12-Lead EKG Monitors/Defibrillator Units and Accessories, in an amount not to exceed \$529,750.46.
