


Roseland Village Masterplan Development

- 2007 Sebastopol Road Urban Vision Plan to develop a 'community commons'
- 2011 Sonoma County CDC purchased site
- January 2016: MidPen Housing selected as Master Developer and approved by BOS
- 2016-2018: Community Engagement
- City Design Review December 2017 and County Design Review May 2017
- City Planning Commission Approval February 2019





Existing Conditions














Plaza Temporal will serve as a community gathering space to allow an active community use during the construction of the master development components.
