

## Approval of Professional Services Agreement for Workers' Compensation Third-Party Administration First Amendment

## CURRENT

- LWP Claims Solutions was chosen as the City's TPA after a full RFP Process.
- The City's has a self-insured workers' compensation program
- Claims are administered by a third party
- Prior vendor (REMIF) had been contracted to administer the City's claims since 1981

### Current

- 3 year contract with LWP Claims Solutions, Inc. for workers' compensation claims administration:
  - Year 1 \$367,834
  - Year 2 \$377,030
  - Year 3 \$386,456
- Optional 3 one-year extensions at a rate to be negotiated.



# Proposed

- To exercise the optional 3 one-year extensions at the rates below. The increase reflects a 2.5% increase each year
- Year 4 \$396,117
- Year 5 \$406,020
- Year 6 \$416,170
- Go back out to RFP in January 2023 for Selection of Workers' Compensation TPA

### BENEFIT

- Competitive third party administration services
- Plan to reduce claim exposure, promoting financial stability
- Enhanced customer service
- Focus on expediting appropriate medical treatment to promote recovery and return to work
- Paperless claim system

### RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Finance Department, Risk Management Division that the Council, by resolution, approve a first amendment for professional services agreement with LWP Claims Solutions, Inc. exercising our 3 one-year extensions.
