## **Non-Congregate Shelter**

- Meet social distancing requirements at Sam Jones Hall
- Mid-March: 45 rooms secured at Sandman Hotel for "at risk" sheltered individuals
- Mid-April: 26 rooms secured at Sandman Hotel for "at risk" unsheltered individuals
- Range of services provides

## **Safe Social Distancing Program**

- May: Create social distancing within existing encampments and protect community at-large
- Finley Community Center parking lot
- 68 tents
- Range of services provided

## **COVID-19 Homeless Services**

- NCS
  - March to June
  - Services Budget \$317,888
  - Outcomes
- SSDP
  - May to June
  - Services Budget \$238,929
  - Outcomes
- Total \$556,817

# **Grant Agreement**

- New Agreement
- Continued operation of NCS and SSDP
- Monthly basis, up to 6 months
- Sonoma County Health Officer orders; City deems necessary
- Amendments City Manager/CAO approval
- FEMA reimbursement
- Total Appropriation \$1,528,860

NCS	\$102,302
SSDP	<u>\$152,508</u>
Total - July 1 to 31	\$254,810

#### Recommendation

It is recommended by the Housing and Community Services Department that Council, by resolution, approve a Grant Agreement with Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Santa Rosa for the provision of COVID-19 related homeless services, including the existing Non-Congregate Shelter Program and the Safe Social Distancing Program through July 31, 2020 in amount notto-exceed \$254,810, and delegating authority to the City Manager or his designee to amend the Agreement to extend the term for these or other similar COVID-19 related homeless services for up to six months with a total aggregate not-to-exceed amount of \$1,528,860 where such amendments are in a form approved by the City Attorney's Office.
