


# Matching Grant application to the Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District for the continued implementation of the Master Plan for A Place to Play Community Park

## SCAPOSD Grant Application

- Grant application Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District's (SCAPOSD) Matching Grant Program
- Grant application for continued implementation of the Master Plan for A Place to Play community park including:
  - 2 multipurpose fields with artificial turf, lighting infrastructure, fencing, spectator seating, restroom building, and pathways
  - Nature pavilion for environmental education
  - Formalized trail system with educational signage around pond and connecting to the Santa Rosa Creek Trail
  - Water hydration stations

## SCAPOSD Grant Application

- SCAPOSD offers a competitive Matching Grant Program
- Projects eligible for the Program include acquisition and/or improvement of real property for open space, agriculture, natural resource or community recreation or a combination.
- The application to SCAPOSD is Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)
- Total estimated project amount is \$4 million
- Maximum grant award 50% of the estimated total value of the project
- The City intends to provide match of \$2 million from Park Development Impact Funds, Zone 1, NW Quadrant.
- Final award amount determined by SCAPOSD Board of Directors - requested match award of \$2 million

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department, that the Council, by resolution,

- 1) authorize the submittal of a matching grant application to the Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District for continued implementation of the Master Plan for A Place to Play community park
- 2) authorize submittal of matching funds for \$2 million from Park Development Impact funds; and

#### RECOMMENDATION

- 3) authorize the Assistant City Manager to negotiate and execute the grant agreement and any amendments thereto, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney; and
- 4) authorize the Chief Financial Officer to increase appropriations by the amount of the grant award.
