BACKGROUND

- Close a significant gap in the transportation network for pedestrians and bicyclists
- Better serve and attract pedestrians and bicyclists
- Lead Agency Caltrans for IS/MND & CE
- Proceed to the (PS&E) and (R/W) phase
- Cooperative Agreement designates City as lead agency in the PS&E development
- Caltrans will be providing independent quality management assessment (QMA)



BACKGROUND



ANALYSIS

Under this Agreement, Caltrans would:

- Provide independent quality management assessment (QMA).
- Caltrans will not require payment.

RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by resolution, approve a no cost Cooperative Agreement No. 04-2273 between the State of California and the City of Santa Rosa authorizing Caltrans to provide independent quality management assessment during the preparation of the Project Plans, Specifications and Estimate (PS&E) for the improvements to the Highway 101 Bicycle and Pedestrian Overcrossing.
