

## 2050 Santa Rosa General Plan Update Waive Council Policy 000-06 & Authorize the Formation of the Community Advisory Committee

## **BACKGROUND**

- The 2050 Santa Rosa General Plan Update commenced in March 2020.
- Community Involvement Strategy describes many outreach tools and the formation and role of the Community Advisory Committee that will help to ensure robust and inclusive public engagement during the 3-year project.
- On August 25, 2020, the Council accepted the **CIS** and agreed to approve a **Waiver of Council Policy 000-06** for the 25 member CAC provided each Council member can seat one member, totaling seven (7).
- Staff was directed to prepare a resolution approving the policy waiver and authorizing the formation of the CAC.

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Planning and Economic Development Department that the Council, by resolution, hereby, waive Council Policy 000-06 and authorize the formation of the twenty-five member Community Advisory Committee subject to the following requirements:

- 1. The Director of Planning and Economic Develoment (PED) will select the first eighteen CAC members based on an open application process to help ensure the CAC reflects diverse neighborhoods, age-groups, community organizations, special interest groups, and business stakeholders within the City.
- 2. Each of the seven (7) Council members will seat one CAC member, totaling seven (7), to round out the diversity of the full CAC.
- 3. In the event a CAC seat is vacated by resignation or non-attendance by a member, the Director of PED or Council member that selected the vacated seat will select the replacement.
