

GENERAL SERVICE AGREEMENT F002195 – SUMMIT PIPELINES, AUBURN, CA – CCTV SERVICE FOR ROSELAND STORM DRAIN PIPES

City Council Meeting November 10, 2020 Flannery Banks Assistant Engineer, Water

BACKGROUND

- On August 10, 2020, the Purchasing division received a request from the Water Department to issue a solicitation for CCTV services for the Roseland drain pipes.
- The approximate length of pipes to be inspected is 18.5 miles.
- All CCTV work shall conform to current National Association of Sewer Service Companies (NASSCO) Pipeline Assessment Certification Program (PACP) standards.

ANALYSIS

- On, September 3, 2020, Invitation for Bids (IFB) 20-83, solicited by the City of Santa Rosa for CCTV Roseland drain pipe services, was opened by Purchasing.
- Of the eighteen (18) prospective bidders, eight (8) responses were received.

RECOMMENDATION

• It is recommended by the Water and Finance Departments that the Council, by resolution, approve the General Services Agreement Number F002195 to Summit Pipelines, Auburn, CA, for CCTV services to the Roseland drain pipe system in an amount not to exceed \$128,200.
