- COVID-19 pandemic resulted in Shelter-in-Place orders
 - March 17, 2020 Sonoma County Public Health Officer
 - March 19, 2020 California Public Health Officer
- CARES Act signed March 27, 2020
 - Provides additional funds to HUD grantees for response to COVID-19
- May 2020 Council Item Santa Rosa allocated funding:
 - \$859,608 CDBG-CV
 - \$65,180 HOPWA





- HUD waivers & guidance provide flexibility and include:
 - Reduced public comment period to 5 days
 - Suspension of CDBG public services cap
 - HOME-funded Tenant-Based Rental Assistance rapid deployment

- Amendment to Action Plan required:
 - To utilize additional CDBG-CV funds;
- Five-Day comment period from November 16 November 20
 - Comments received will be included in the Amendment to Action Plan



Rental Assistance

- Section 8 Housing Choice Vouchers
 - Over 2,000 households assisted
- City-wide COVID-19 Rental Assistance Program
 - Launched Summer 2020
 - Up to \$600,000 available to assist low-income households that has reduced or lost wages
- CDBG-CV3 Funds
 - Provide additional tranche of funds to provide short term rental assistance



Recommendation

The proposed action will authorize submittal of Substantial CARES Act Amendment No. 2 to the Fiscal Year 2019/2020 Action Plan (Plan) to the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) to utilize new federal funds for the City's COVID-19 response; accept and appropriate additional Community Development Block Grant – Coronavirus (CDBG-CV3) funds in the amount of \$1,281,401, as allocated to Santa Rosa under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act). Approval of this action will allow deployment of the City's CDBG-CV3 funds for Rental Assistance/Housing Instability to income eligible households that have been impacted by COVID-19.
