#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works and Finance Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the Fourth Amendment to General Services Agreement Number F001438 with ADS-Myers, Inc., Gardenville, Nevada, to increase compensation by \$28,343.46, for a not to exceed a total amount of \$2,509,957.44 which includes a \$100,000 contingency, for janitorial services to the Portland Loo located outside of City Hall Annex.

#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Transportation and Public Works submitted a request to Purchasing to add janitorial services to the Portland Loo located outside of City Hall Annex.

#### BACKGROUND

On June 25, 2019, City Council approved issuance of Purchase Order 159531 for the purchase of the Portland Loo with Madden Industrial Craftsmen Inc. The Portland Loo was installed on September 3, 2020.

#### PRIOR CITY COUNCIL REVIEW

Contract Award on June 20, 2017.

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## <u>ANALYSIS</u>

Transportation and Public Works received a proposal from ADS-Myers, Inc. to add janitorial service to the newly installed Portland Loo. The review of the proposal is within service parameters and costs associated to City wide services currently being provided to the City under this agreement.

On June 20, 2017, the City Council awarded General Services Agreement F001438 for a five-year term with one (1) five-year extension option in the amount of \$2,305,041 with a \$100,000 contingency. See contract history in the chart below:
