WaterNow Alliance Project Accelerator Program

 Twice yearly, WaterNow selects projects to receive specialized professional technical and program assistance (up to 250 Hours)

<u>Goals</u>

- Leverage deep bench of Policy, Advocacy, & Communications Strategy Expertise
- Make water use efficiency, water reuse, and green stormwater infrastructure programs successful
- Overcome roadblocks, path to implementation



Spanish Language Water Use Efficiency Enhancements Project

- Anecdotally, we know that we are not seeing the same program uptake in our Spanish-speaking communities
- Traditional measures (translation, etc.) may not be effective
- Utilizing WaterNow expertise to develop strategies



Spanish Language Water Use Efficiency Enhancements Project

<u>Proposed Tasks</u>

- Conduct staff interviews and develop research into existing practices
- Conduct surveys and receive direct feedback from our LatinX community
- Final Report recommendations for Santa Rosa Water



Memorandum of Understanding

- Outlines the responsibilities of the parties
 - 250 hours of technical services at no-cost to Santa Rosa Water
 - Scope of Work (attachment A)
 - 6 to 9 month project timeline
- A typical "standard agreement" for professional services is not being considered because of grant/grantee relationship and non-profit considerations



Recommendation Contract Review Subcommittee

- Staff are seeking the subcommittees recommendation of approval of the MOU
- The MOU will be brought to the BPU for consideration at their January 21, 2021 Regular Board Meeting
