

Courthouse Square Bollards Project Update

Downtown Subcommittee February 4, 2021

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PURPOSE

- Protect against an "intentional act" by those seeking to cause harm
- Save lives and prevent injuries caused by vehicle accidents adjacent to the sidewalk
- Reduce medical emergencies where the driver loses control and enters the sidewalk area


TIMELINE

- July 2019 Project update to subcommittee
- January 2020 Design-Build proposals received
- March 2020 Contract awarded to M3 Integrated Services, Inc. of Santa Rosa, CA
- February 2021 Design complete
- March 2021 Construction scheduled to begin



PROJECT SCOPE

- Construct two 85-foot-long traffic-rated bollard arrays
- Bollard height and spacing: 54" and 60"
- Replace curb ramps on the Square along 3rd and 4th Streets
- Two curb ramps at north side of 4th Street and Mendocino Avenue
- One curb ramp at southwest corner of Courthouse Square West and 4th Street



DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS


- Color & Finish
 - Jet Black Powder Coat
 - Smooth Finish
 - Reflective Tape
- Top Style
 - Slant
- Existing permeable pavers will be replaced in kind
- Shallow Foundation
 - ▶ Approx. 18" thick




CONSTRUCTION CONSIDERATIONS
