FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR THE USE OF MODULAR TEMPORARY FIRE STATION TRAILER AND APPARATUS TENT BETWEEN THE MENLO PARK FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA

This First Amendment to Agreement for the Use of Modular Temporary Fire Station Trailer and Apparatus Tent ("Amendment") is made as of the date on which this Amendment is fully executed by the parties as indicated on the signature page, by and between the Menlo Park Fire Protection District, a California Special District, ("District") and the City of Santa Rosa, a California municipal corporation ("City").

RECITALS

- A. City and District entered into the Agreement for the Use of Modular Temporary Fire Station Trailer and Apparatus Tent dated February 6, 2018 ("Agreement") commencing on February 6, 2018 and terminating on July 31,2020, whereby District grants to City the exclusive right to use and occupy the Modular Station and Apparatus Tent (collectively, the "Facilities") for such purposes as City deems necessary and appropriate.
- B. City and District now desire to amend the Agreement for the purpose of extending the Term by three (3) years.

<u>AMENDMENT</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. EXTENDED TERM

Pursuant to Section 4 of the Agreement, the parties hereby agree to extend the Term of the Agreement for an additional three (3) years of time from August 1, 2020 through July 31, 2023 (the "Extended Term").

2. USE OF FACILITIES

As compensation for the use of the Facilities during the Extended Term, City shall pay District One Dollar (\$1.00) per year.

3. COUNTERPARTS AND ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES

This Amendment and future documents relating thereto may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original and all of which together constitute one agreement. Counterparts and/or signatures delivered by facsimile, pdf or City-approved electronic means have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature. Both City and District wish to permit this Amendment and future documents

relating thereto to be electronically signed in accordance with applicable federal and California law. Either party to this agreement may revoke its permission to use electronic signatures at any time for future documents by providing notice pursuant to the Agreement. The parties agree that electronic signatures, by their respective signatories are intended to authenticate such signatures and to give rise to a valid, enforceable, and fully effective agreement. The City reserves the right to reject any signature that cannot be positively verified by the City as an authentic electronic signature.

All other terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
