

FUELS MITIGATION PILE BURNING

CURRENT

- Property owners in and around the City's Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) are taking measures to mitigate the risk of wildfires to our community.
- In some areas of the City, the reduction and physical removal of vegetation (fuels) is not practical or feasible due to reasons such as location or topographical features.



PROPOSED

- Use the Community Wildfire Prevention Plan (CWPP) to assist with the treatment of vegetation.
- The treatment of vegetation within the WUI can reduce the risk of loss and damage from wildfire.
- An action identified in the CWPP to mitigate the threat of wildfire is to establish permitting protocols for the use of prescribed fire pile burning.

RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Fire Department that Council adopt an Ordinance adding Chapter 9-28 to the Santa Rosa City Code pertaining to Fuels Mitigation Pile Burning to allow private landowners to obtain a permit from the Fire Department to perform pile burning to reduce wildfire hazards to accomplish a combination of fire protection and resource management goals.
