# CURRENT

- On March 23, 2021, the City Council approved RES-2021-052
- The Resolution authorized certain City officials to enter into agreements with HCD for CDBG-DR and CDBG-MIT programs relative to 2017 Tubbs Fire
- On March 26, 2021, HCD revised their guidance for the resolution requiring the City to include the amount allocated to the City for CDBG-DR and CDBG-MIT programs
- This resolution is due to HCD by April 23, 2021

# PROPOSED

- The City Council must find good cause to consider the item as it was not included on the preliminary agenda
- Notification from HCD to revise RES-2021-052 was after the preliminary council agenda for April 13, 2021 was published
- There is no scheduled meeting for April 20
- Council can move to revise RES-2021-052 to include the total CDBG-DR and CDBG-MIT funding allocation

# RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Finance Department that the Council, by motion: 1) find good cause to consider this item, notwithstanding that the item did not appear on the preliminary agenda; and 2) approve a revision to Resolution No. RES-2021-052, which authorized the City Manager and Assistant City Manager to enter into agreements with California Housing and Community Development for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) programs in response to the 2017 Tubbs Fire, to include the total allocation of CDBG funds not to exceed \$33,988,033.19 for the Disaster Recovery Infrastructure and Mitigation Resilient Infrastructure Programs.
