CURRENT

- Staff presented four study sessions for the use of the PG&E settlement funds.
- The Fire Department identified two of the seven highest priority projects that are ready to begin pending funding availability.



PROPOSED

 Appropriate funding into two separate project accounts; JL key 05109 in the amount of \$5,250,000 for the implementation of a comprehensive vegetation management program and JL key 05110 in the amount of \$2,750,000 for the implementation of a Wildland Resiliency and Response Strategic Plan.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Fire Department that Council, by resolution, authorize the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate the funds previously approved for the Fire Department from the PG&E settlement into two separate project accounts. One project in the amount of \$5,250,000 is to be allocated for the implementation of a comprehensive Vegetation Management Program and the second project in the amount of \$2,750,000 is to be allocated for the implementation of a Wildland Resiliency and Response strategic plan. Both projects are among the top seven highest priority projects related to wildfire preparedness, mitigation and resiliency.
