ESRI Enterprise Agreement Renewal

ESRI provides the GIS software used to create all internal and public-facing maps in use by the City. In addition, ESRI tools provide the platform behind all the GIS data, maps and applications that are used to improve access to city information and services.



ESRI Enterprise Agreement Renewal

 GIS maps and applications continue to be the standard method for creating and sharing spatial data and information relating to City infrastructure and services. As GIS work expands, including supporting the new GISbased asset management software, it has become financially desirable to expand to a citywide enterprise agreement with ESRI. It is in the City's best interest to continue that partnership.



ESRI Enterprise Agreement Renewal

 This three-year Enterprise Agreement will continue to provide unlimited City-wide access to all ESRI software. This will allow better flexibility and quicker access to deploy new GIS application features and functions as they arise, as well as maintain a lower costper-unit for licensed software.



 It is recommended by the Information Technology Department that the Council, by resolution: 1) waive competitive bidding pursuant to Section 3-08.100, subdivision (D) of the Santa Rosa City Code; and 2) approve a new three-year Small **Enterprise Agreement with Environmental** Systems Research Institute, Inc. (ESRI) for Geographic Information System (GIS) software in the amount of \$495,000, which when combined with the City's prior three year agreement represents a total contract amount with ESRI of \$945,000 over six years.
