Community Center public rentals have resumed as of July 31 with permit holders following current Health Orders.

McDonald Avenue Rural Cemetery Tour held on August 14. All 4 sold times sold out.

Neighborhood Services is offering a new Kindergarten after-school program which began on Monday, August 16 at the Steele Lane Community Center. As of August 16, 19 kindergarteners from Steele Lane Elementary School are enrolled in the program.

The third and final Dutch Flohr Park Community Meeting was held on Thursday, August 19, 2021 at 5:30pm. The conceptual master plan was presented.

August 23, Recreation staff will participate in a Temporary Evacuation Point scenario at A Place to Play Park.

Summer programming is wrapping up.
