






Lake Mendocino Storage

Sonoma WaterTemporary Urgency Change Order

May 3, 2021, the WAC unanimously adopted a temporary methodology for allocation of water deliveries for this summer (July-October)


June 14, 2021, State Water Board Order requiring Sonoma Water reduce their diversions from lower Russian River by 20% compared to 2020

Sonoma Water issued allocations to all contractors under temporary methodology beginning July 1

Monthly allocation beginning in July 2021 for Santa Rosa is up to 20% less compared to 2020

Sonoma Water has been tracking diversions for deliveries to contractors in addition to water quality, fishery and storage metrics.






