RFP SUMMARY

- RFP issued July 23, 2021; due August 11, 2021
- Thirty (30) vouchers available
- RFP targeted to projects dedicated to permanent supportive housing for people who have experienced homelessness
- Proposals for 62 units of PBV across three projects were received



Bennett Valley Apartments Proposal

- Developer: Freebird Development Company, LLC
- New Construction (former site of Bennett Valley Senior Center Complex)
- 62 Units; 49% of units targeted for homeless individuals and families; 30
 Project Based Vouchers
- On-site staff: full-time Clinical Case Manager, a full-time Services Coordinator,
 Program Manager.
- On-site services: clinical assessments, counseling, case conferencing, coordination for off-site primary health care services, case management, housing stability support, health education, recreational activities, community-building activities, financial literacy, computer training, employment assistance, conflict resolution and mediation and access to offsite vocation training.

Bennett Valley Apartments Proposal

- Affordability Mix
 - 32 units @ 30% AMI; 29 units @ 50% AMI; 1 unrestricted manager's unit
- Unit Mix
 - 19 0-bedroom, 19 1-bedroom, 12 2-bedroom, 12 3bedroom
- Environmental Review
 - National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Environmental Assessment complete; exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

Bennett Valley Apartments -Scoring

Category	Points
Project dedication to housing the homeless	15/20- 49% of units will be dedicated to housing the formerly homeless
Experience with similar projects	10/10- Four completed projects in region; five projects in predevelopment, significant development and management experience outside the region
Project Location	10/10 – Project is located in a census tract with a poverty rate at or below 20% determined in the most recent American Community Survey 5-Year Estimate.
Commitment to providing to long term affordable housing	20/20- Self-scores for CDLAC and MHP were in top 1% of total possible points. Applying to MHP due 9/20/2021.
On-site supportive services	20/20 – Extensive and targeted on-site supportive services for formerly homeless population
Affordability	15/20 – Project has 51% of restricted units or more are at 50% AMI or below. The unit affordability mix is: 32 units targeted to households with incomes up to 30% of Area Median Income ("AMI"), 29 units targeted to household incomes up to 50% AMI, and one unrestricted manager unit
