<u>August 31</u> - City Council unanimously approved the name change for Creekside Open Space to Mary Traverso Open Space. City materials like maps and brochures will be updated with the new name at the next printing.

<u>September 1</u> – Steele Lane Community Center senior programs expanded, with enrollment increasing daily. Bingo is now offered two days a week, Monday & Wednesdays, and enrollment has increased from pre-covid numbers!

<u>September 4</u> – Father's Day Car show on Another Day event at Juilliard Park. Over 1000 in attendance.

<u>September 7</u> – Neighborhood Services opened Sports Clinics at Comstock and Steele Lane (COVID modified program as gym space was not available for full sports league program we have been running).

<u>September 9</u> - A Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued to hire a landscape architecture firm to revitalize the playground area at South Davis Neighborhood Park. RFPs are due on October 5, 2021. The project is funded through California State Parks Per Capita Program. The City will receive \$285,291 in Per Capita funding.
