

ADOPTION OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING, UNITS 4 - SUPPORT SERVICES, UNIT 6 – PROFESSIONAL, AND UNIT 7 – TECHNICAL

BACKGROUND

The City's representatives and representatives of International Brotherhood of Teamsters ("IBT") Local Union Number 856, representing the City's Units 4 – Support Services, Unit 6 – Professional, and Unit 7 – Technical, have met and conferred concerning a successor Memorandum of Understanding and have agreed on a contract.

• The new contract will be for July 1, 2021- June 30, 2024

Primary Economics

- 3% salary increase effective November 7, 2021
- 2.5% salary increase effective the first full pay period following April 1, 2022
- 2.5% salary increase effective the first full pay period following July 1, 2023
- A one-time, non-pensionable lump sum payment of \$5,000

Additional Changes

- Addition of Cesar Chavez Holiday
- \$500 annually for wellness

Fiscal Impact

The estimated cost of this Resolution for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 is \$3,461,740 with an estimated ongoing increased cost of \$3,794,956 annually. Funding for these expenditure increases is not included in the FY 2021-22 adopted budget and is being appropriated from the funds which are affected by the increases. The impact to the General Fund in FY 2021-22 is \$1,903,514, and will come from the unassigned fund balance.

RECOMMENDATION

The Human Resources Department and the City Manager's Office recommend that the Council, by resolution, adopt the Memorandum of Understanding for an agreement for and on behalf of, the employees in the City's Bargaining Units 4 -Support Services, Unit 6 - Professional, and Unit 7 - Technical, represented by the Teamsters Local Union Number 856.
