





# Lake Mendocino Storage

19,995 acre-feet


# Lake Sonoma Storage

# Cumulative Sonoma Water Russian River Diversions (Million Gallons)


2020 Total Diversions 2020 Non-Exempt Diversions 2021 Total Diversions 2021 Non-Exempt Diversions

Compliance with the 20% reduction in cumulative diversions over 2020 (shown in box) is applied during non-exempt period, i.e. when limit is not suspended.

# Santa Rosa Cumulative Drought Reductions

## SANTA ROSA DROUGHT RESPONSE



- In October, the community reduced water use by 29% compared to 2020
- Utilized 94% of target allocations from Sonoma Water during this timeframe
- City of Santa Rosa Stage 3 Mandatory Restrictions Remain in effect

- Continue asking customers to eliminate water waste and adopt water conserving behaviors
