(TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER) - 440 HEARN AVE - FILE NO. DR18-086

BACKGROUND: Remove an existing 55-foot mono-pole telecommunications tower and replace it with a 65-foot mono-tree telecommunications tower.

6.2 CONCEPT DESIGN REVIEW - SANTA ROSA HOUSING FIRST - 80 COLLEGE AVE - FILE NO. DR19-037

BACKGROUND: A new 3-story, 54-unit multi-family residential project for formerly homeless individuals, approx. 36,915 square-feet.

Project Planner: Ross

Acting Chair Weigl introduced the item. (5:03 pm)

City Planner Adam Ross gave the staff presentation and responded to Board Members' questions.

Architect Frank Biscoti gave a presentation.

Acting Chair Weigl opened public comments at 5:27 pm.

Gregory Feron, Sonoma Applied Village Services - Supported the project but expressed concern that there is not enough parking; the project looks more like a jail than housing. Supportive services are needed in the housing.

Acting Chair Weigl closed public comments at 5:31 pm.

The Board commented on the following:

Break up the horizontal scale and massing. Refine/maximize the courtyard with plantings and activities for a sense of place. Provide bike lanes where feasible. Address pedestrian connections to crosswalks and traffic signals. Consider alternative to chain link fence at the SMART line. Revisit building colors for a more subdued palette. Consider adding storage units/areas for bicycles. Consider butterfly solar canopy to shade parking and bicycles. Provide trash enclosure design at next submittal. Consider adding a two-way drive aisle with parking on each side; explore ways to increase parking. Revisit parking areas to make room for first-responder access/turn around areas. Replace palms with trees that provide more shade for the courtyard and south elevation. Plant trees along the College Avenue sidewalk if feasible. Consider adding stoops or balconies on College Ave as an amenity and for eyes on the street. Add glazing to the Northwest corner; implement 4-sided architecture (ISO corner view to the East.)
