6. SCHEDULED ITEMS

6.1 CONCEPT DESIGN REVIEW - 1650 W. STEELE LANE
APARTMENTS - 1650 W. STEELE LANE - FILE NO. DR20-008
BACKGROUND: The project proposes a 36-unit three story courtyard
style apartment complex, and one 15-foot tall structure, which houses a
two-level automated parking structure. The project is within the North
Station Specific Plan and Priority Development Area subject to Resilient

City Development Measures. The Project includes a 100% Supplemental Density Bonus Application subject to approval of a Minor Use Permit to allow the 36 units. The Density Bonus includes a requested Concession from parking for a total of 36 parking spaces. Nine (bicycle parking spaces are proposed in lockable storage compartments).

COMMENT SUMMARY

Dynamic material and colors for the courtyard façades is encouraged; consider reducing the size of the courtyard for an unloading zone; Refer to Design Guideline Sections 4.10 2L North Station Area Specific Plan Design; 4.10 3A, Avoidance of Blank Walls; and 4.10 2F Urban Plazas. Consider adding materials to the palate; make sure there is continuity of the accessory buildings with the finishes; a color study of the grey color is recommended, to possibly bring greys to the verticals and in the bays from the cmu courtyard walls, for color variation; recommended 1 parking space per unit; consider vines on the cmu courtyard walls; consider adding tile at the returns of the courtyard element walls; enhanced landscaping, consider mechanical well screening for wells facing West Steele Ln; incorporate glazing into top of garage doors; a traffic study is encouraged; add tile and landscape details to next submittal.

7. BOARD MEMBER REPORTS

Board Member Weigl addressed the Public Comment regarding trees and the climate action plan. Trees are not the only climate action solution: good design, passive solar design, attention to recyclable materials, embodied carbon, etc. are also important elements.
