- The City is not changing the name of the Recreation and Parks Department
- BOCS to rescind their recommendation from the May 23, 2023, BOCS meeting to change the name of the BOCS to the Parks and Recreation Board and vote to approve new BOCS name to the Recreation and Parks Board

SUBCOMMITTEE BACKGROUND

- Created by the BOCS on date October 26, 2022
- Purpose: review and discuss options for updating Ordinances and Bylaws governing the BOCS and bring recommendations before full BOCS
- BOCS subcommittee was paused by the full BOCS on February 22, 2023
