**Title:** REPORT - DECLARATION OF RESULTS FOR THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2018, FOR (1) THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING MEMBERS FOR THREE DISTRICT-BASED OFFICES OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR DISTRICTS 2, 4, AND 6, EACH FOR A FULL TERM OF FOUR YEARS; (2) SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS MEASURE O RELATING TO THE SALES TAX; AND (3) CITY OF SANTA ROSA MEASURE N RELATING TO THE HOUSING RECOVERY BOND

**BACKGROUND:** Pursuant to City Charter Section 30 and the California Elections Code, the City Council called a General Municipal Election for Tuesday, November 6, 2018, for (1) the purpose of electing one candidate for each City Council office for Districts 2, 4 and 6, each for a full term of four years; (2) submitting to the voters Measure O relating to the Sales Tax; and (3) City of Santa Rosa Measure N relating to the Housing Recovery Bond.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended by the City Clerk that the Council, by resolution, declare the results of the Consolidated General Municipal Election held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, for (1) the election of John Sawyer for District 2 of the City Council, the election of Victoria Fleming for District 4 of the City Council, and the election of Tom Schwedhelm for District 6 of the City Council, each for a full term of four years; (2) City of Santa Rosa Measure O relating to the Sales Tax; and (3) City of Santa Rosa Measure N relating to the Housing Recovery Bond.
