Title:	REPORT - EXTENSION OF PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL HOMELESS EMERGENCY AND HOMELESS POLICY SUBCOMMITTEE REPORT: COMPREHENSIVE HOMELESS SERVICES STRATEGY, EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS WORK PLAN, AND REQUESTED COST ESTIMATES				

BACKGROUND: On August 9, 2016, pursuant to the authority set forth in California Government Code Sections 8630 thru 8634, Council, by Resolution No. 28839, formally proclaimed a local homeless emergency within Santa Rosa. Section 8630 requires that the Council review the need for continuing the local emergency at least every 30 days until such local emergency is terminated. On August 30, 2016, September 27, and again on October 25, Council, by Resolution Nos. 28851, 28863, and 28876 approved an extension of the declaration of local homeless emergency. In light of the continuing conditions of homelessness within the city, staff is recommending that the Council maintain the proclamation in full force and effect at this time. Staff is also asking Council to accept the Comprehensive Homeless Services Strategy and Emergency Declarations Work Plan, and provide direction regarding the requested cost estimates.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended by the Housing and Community Services Department that the Council, 1) by resolution, approve an extension of Resolution No. 28839 which formally proclaimed a local homeless emergency within Santa Rosa and 2) by motion, accept the Comprehensive Homeless Services Strategy and Emergency Declarations Work Plan; and 3) provide direction regarding the requested cost estimates.
