SANTA ROSA AMENDING TITLE 9 OF THE SANTA ROSA CITY CODE BY REPEALING CHAPTER 9-24 PERTAINING TO ADMINISTRATIVE ENFORCEMENT OF COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH ORDERS IN ITS ENTIRETY; ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 9-24 PERTAINING TO THE INSPECTION, MAINTENANCE AND REGISTRATION OF REAL PROPERTIES WHICH EXIST AS UNMAINTAINED

VACANT LOTS OR WHICH CONTAIN VACANT OR ABANDONED BUILDINGS; AND AMENDING

SECTION 18-20.302.4 OF THE SANTA ROSA CITY CODE

RECOMMENDATION: This ordinance, introduced at the February 13, 2023, Regular Meeting by a 5-0 -2 vote (Fleming and C. Rogers absent), seeks to amend Titles 9 and 18 of the Santa Rosa City Code. This involves streamlining the code by repealing the outdated Chapter 9-24 (which contains obsolescent COVID-19 public health order regulations) and replacing it with a new Chapter 9-24 establishing a comprehensive regulatory framework for unmaintained vacant lots and properties with vacant or abandoned buildings. Lastly, the ordinance amends Section 18-20.302.4 by proposing

clarifying language regarding the definition of "weeds."
